PGP Admissions Policy and Procedure for PGP Batch 2017-19

The minimum eligibility criteria for receiving Call Letter for Writing Ability Test (WAT) and Personal Interview (PI):

The minimum eligibility criteria used by IIM Amritsar in the PGP admissions for the academic year 2017-19 are given below in Table 1:

The candidates meeting the requirements mentioned in Table-1 are eligible to be shortlisted for Writing Ability Test (WAT) and Personal Interview (PI). The criterion mentioned above are intended to be minimum eligibility criteria and does not imply entitlement. The actual number of candidates to be shortlisted will depend upon the total intake for the academic year 2017-19.

This shortlisting of the candidates will be facilitated by the IIM Rohtak (convening IIM) along with all the participating IIMs.

Final Merit list for Admission to the PG Programme (PGP) at IIM Amritsar

A two-stage selection process will be used by IIM Amritsar to select the candidates for admission to its 3rd batch of postgraduate programme in management. Accordingly, the following selection criteria are applied in two stages for all the eligible candidates applied for admission to IIM Amritsar, and appeared in the interview process facilitated by IIM Rohtak and other older IIMs.

Stage-1: The WAT and PI scores will be pooled from the databases of common admission process convened by IIM Rohtak, IIM Kozhikode and other old IIMs.

Stage 2: The final merit list for admission to IIM Amritsar will be prepared based on the criteria given in Table-2.

Work Experience:

The work experience will carry a weight of 5%, which will be computed based on the length of the service period. The length of the experience considered will be till July 31, 2016. *Only fulltime on job experience after graduation will be taken into consideration while experience acquired during apprenticeship/Training/Internship/Academic Project work/Articleship/Pre-graduation period/the work performed as an integral part of curricular requirement will not be considered.* A candidate with a work experience of 6 months or above will be eligible for work experience score. A sample illustration of the marks awarded is given in the Annexure 1.

Academic/Gender diversity:

To ensure diversity, 5% marks will be awarded to female or non-engineering candidates. However, a particular candidate is entitled to diversity score of 5% either from gender or academic diversity. A candidate with any bachelor's degree other than Engineering/Technology (B.Tech./B.E. or equivalent degrees) will be eligible for academic diversity score.

Reservation Policy

IIM Amritsar will follow Government of India reservation policy for admission to Central Educational Institutions (CEIs).

Any dispute concerning Admissions for the PGP Batch 2017-2019 would be subject to jurisdiction of the competent Courts within the territorial jurisdiction of the city of Kozhikode only.

Additional Information (the candidates are advised to read the following carefully)

1. Candidates who appear for CAT 2016 and opted for admission to IIM Amritsar are only eligible for admission to IIM Amritsar.
2. Each IIM shortlists candidates for GD/WAT and PI, based on its own criteria. Hence, it is possible to observe variations in the lists of candidates shortlisted by different IIMs.
3. Subsequent to the PI and WAT/CT, the merit list for admissions will be prepared by IIM Kozhikode tentatively during May 2017. The required number of admission offers will be released from this merit list. Hard copies of the admission offers will be issued only to those candidates who send the completed offer acceptance form together with the required payment.
4. A limited number of candidates will be kept in the waiting list. Offers to the candidates in the waiting list will depend upon the number of candidates not accepting the offers from the initial list.
5. All the candidates are advised to check their registered emails regularly and visit IIM Amritsar website for updates on admission related activities.
6. If a candidate fails to confirm the admission formalities within the stipulated time period, for whatsoever reasons, the seat will be automatically forfeited and the next candidate in the waiting list will get the offer.
7. IIM Amritsar reserves the right to change, modify or adopt any new admission policy and process to comply with Government/Judicial requirements or that it deems necessary, and which best suits its purpose of identifying and admitting the most appropriate candidates to the post graduate programme (PGP).
8. A candidate receiving the admission offer from IIM Amritsar and accepting the offer within the stipulated date needs to send along with the offer acceptance, an offer acceptance fee of Rs.50,000/-. The candidate will have to register on the registration day for the programme which will be intimated to them, and pay the necessary fees to complete the admission process. A candidate withdrawing from the programme can get the fee refunded after deducting the processing charges as per govt. norms (F. No. 21-166/2007-TS.II). If the withdrawal is happening after the closure of the admission window (to be intimated later) no refund of fee will be made.
9. All communication pertaining to IIM Amritsar PGP admissions will be done only through the admissions office of IIM Kozhikode.
10. IIM Amritsar does not allow deferment of admission offers to subsequent years.
11. Any misrepresentation or suppression of information by a candidate will lead to immediate disqualification of their candidature from the admission process.
